**Location:** **Life O' Riley Farm B&B** intersection of Riley Road and County T, Hickory Grove Township {just outside of Boscobel, WI} <http://www.bbonline.com/united-states/wisconsin/boscobel/lifeoriley.html> See new installation of photovoltaic system that generates electricity from the sun and feeds it to the grid. Chickens, greenhouse, huge garden, stone quarry with party potential....yippee!

**Accommodations on the farm:**

**1) The Schoolhouse** –Kitchenette, small living-room, and bath with shower-- has 2 queen beds in loft with floor space for sleeping bag/air mattress. Two queen fold-out couch/futons on main floor. Two people /bed =8 people plus floor space for one or 2 more. **First to reserve - first to get a bed.**

**2) Second building** has one queen bed and one single-person, fold-out futon couch. Has own kitchenette and bath with shower. & Floor space for sleeping bag. = 3+ people. **First to reserve - first to get a bed.**

**3)** Depending on weather, plenty of places to pitch a tent.

**Cost** for the 2 buildings @ Life O Riley Farm will be evenly divided among members using the beds. Those staying on air mattresses or tents --@ \$10.00/each. Estimated cost right now for the first eleven (11) people who use beds = \$35.00/person for the weekend.
